DRAMA: "GRAPE EATERS" (DRA005)

Aim of Script: To provoke Christians to share the Gospel with others.

Use of Script: In an All Age Worship service the script could be preceded by

teaching that the Church has been entrusted with sharing the Gospel with others. However sometimes we can be tempted to hold on to everything that God has given us and forget that there

is a dying world out there that needs to hear the Gospel

message of salvation.

The script could be followed by encouraging people to think about how they could get involved with the Mission of the church

in whatever way the Lord asks them to.

Main themes: Mission, Evangelism, Outreach

Biblical references: Matthew 28:19-20, Mark 16:15

Cast: Katy, Fred, Susan, John, Anne

Props: A bunch of grapes for each person, two lounging chairs, five

ordinary chairs, two small tables with bunches of grapes on

them.

(Enter Fred and Katy carrying a bunch of grapes each and eating them)

Fred: Delicious.

Katy: So juicy.

Fred: An absolutely perfect taste-sensation!

(Fred & Katy sit down on reclining chairs with a small table next to them with more bunches of grapes on the tables.)

Katy: You know Fred; I could eat these all day and never get tired of them.

Fred: So could I......do you think we've got enough here to last us until tomorrow

morning?

Katy: Mmmmmm I think so....but just in case I will ring Free Stores to send us round

another delivery later on this evening.

Fred: Good thinking girl....that's one of the things I love about you....you are so

organised.

Katy: Fred do you think we should take a few of these grapes round to Emma next

door? I am pretty sure that she has never eaten grapes before.

Fred: Have you forgotten Katy that our grape eating group are coming around later,

and we really need to get this place tidy.

Katy: Oh gosh I nearly forgot.....well remembered Fred......Emma probably wouldn't

like grapes anyway.

(Fred and Katy jump up, push away the reclining chairs and lay out five chairs in a circle. They put a table in the centre. As soon as they finish Susan enters carrying a bunch of grapes)

Susan: Hi Fred and Katy......I have an amazing testimony to share with you this

evening.

Fred: Great...

(Enter John and Anne carrying a bunch of grapes each)

Katy: Welcome John and Anne.....it's so good to see you.....come and sit down.

John: So what are we waiting for? Let's get stuck into these grapes.

(All start eating grapes)

Anne: Mmmm these grapes are so good.

Fred: You're right....they really are. Grapes are good

All: All the time

Fred: All the time

All: Grapes are good!

Katy: I have been thinking that perhaps we should be getting out and sharing our

grapes with people who haven't tasted them before.

Anne: Sharing our grapes with non- grape eaters? What a strange idea Katy.

Katy: We all know how utterly delicious grapes are and I have been feeling rather

guilty that we are keeping them all to ourselves.

John: When would I possibly have time to share my grapes with other people? I

already attend four grape-eating groups a week and that's not including

Sunday.

Fred: Katy has been having these rather strange ideas recently. She even wanted

us to take some of our grapes round to Emma next door

Anne: As if Emma would have accepted them! People don't want our grapes

Katy.....they will only throw them back in your face.

Katy: But we haven't even tried to share them yet.

Susan: Talking of sharing, I have an amazing testimony I want to share with you this

evening.

John: Go on Susan....we can't wait to hear it.

Susan: Yesterday I came across this new batch of grapes (Holds up bunch of seedless

grapes)



Anne: Look at the colour of them.....aren't they beautiful?

Susan: You need to try one of these (Hands out a grape to each person)

Fred: Thanks.....oh wow......Susan......that's amazing

John: Completely seedless.....what a new experience in grape-eating.

Anne: I see what you mean.

Susan: You know what this means don't you?

Katy: We could offer these grapes to children as well as to adults

Fred: Oh Katy....do be quiet

John: Go on Susan.....what do seedless grapes mean?

Susan: Our lives will never be the same again.....no more pips to worry about.....I

can't wait to share my testimony on Sunday.
